Welcome to my presentation. The liars' convention is now open. I will show clips from various cartoon shows. Every clip is about lying, contemplation of or consequences of this subject.

My first clip is from the Digimon series. The First Liar in our convention is Demidevimon. Roll tape.

Clip Show: Digimon episode---Forget About It! (Intro to Demidevimon)

My next clip is from The Smurfs. Our next liar in the convention is Gargamel. Roll tape. (Show the part of the episode where

Gargamel is trying to improve his spell over Smurfy Acres)

This is false advertising. Gargamel was using a fake advertisement to lure and trap the Smurfs with his deal.

My next clip is from The Flintstones. Our next liars in the convention are Fred and Barney. Roll tape. (Show the very first part of this episode. This should be up to the point where Fred and Barney exit.)

This is the little white lie. Fred wanted to play poker instead of doing what he said he'd do.

My next clips are from The Simpsons. Our next liar in the convention is Lisa Simpson. Roll tape. (Show Lisa playing sick, cheating on her test, and then her 'A')

Lisa being the current liar in our convention has cheated on her test.

Our last liar in the convention is Cody from Digimon. Roll the Clips. (These clips include: the platform's destruction, the pressure not to tell a lie, Cody contemplates, his lie, and the digi-egg of reliability respectively.)

What do you think about the liars in this convention? Do you think any of them did the right or moral thing? What would you do? Would you believe in the top three of our liars if you were in everyone else's shoes? Would you lie in the case of our bottom two liars if you were in their shoes? Assume that God exists, what would he think about these situations and the lies these six have told? The liars' convention is closed. Thanks for watching!
