This poll appears to be a random selection type of study. The poll was done in March of 2004 by CNN and by USA Today. The margin of error was 5%.

Description of the Attached Graph:

The attached graph is a bar graph. The purpose of this graph is to show the percentage of people who do vs. do not think that rising gas prices will hurt the pocket book. The graph shows that 42% of people polled do not think a financial burden will happen. This leaves the other 58% of people polled thinking that financial hardship is going to happen.

This is how the legend was made. The legend was made by counting the characters in the original question. This does not include spaces, but does include the

quotation marks. “ = one character. After this count, calculations of the percentages of red and blue ensued. The character count was 112. Calculations went as follows: There was 42 percent of people who said “will not”. The multiplication of the proper figures meant that 47.04 characters would be blue. The same happened with red (“will”) and the calculations that ensued meant that 64.96 characters would be red.

Conclusions:
