Praise-boast, exhalt, magnify, bless, testify, worship, give thanks, sing, rejoice,

Praise defeats the enemy.

See Nehemiah 9: 5-38-

Stand up and bless the Lord your God forever and ever: and blessed be thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise. (v.1)

O Lord our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! Psalm 8:9

I will praise thee, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will shew forth all thy marvellous works. I will be glad and rejoice in thee; I will sing praise to thy name, O thou most High. Psalm 8:1-2

Sing praises to the Lord, which dwelleth in Zion; declare among the people his doings. Psalm 9:11

Grant thee according to thine own heart, and fulfil all thy counsel. We will rejoice in Thy salvation, and in the name of Our God we will set up our banners; the Lord fulfill all thy petitions. Psalm 20:4-5

The king shall joy in Thy strength, O Lord; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he rejoice! Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah. For thou preventest him with the blessings of goodness: thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head. He asked life of thee, and thou gavest it him, even length of days forever and ever. His glory is great in thy salvation: honour and majesty hast thou laid upon him. For thou hast made him most blessed forever: thou hast made him exceeding glad with Thy countenance. Psalm 21:1-6

My God, my God, why hast Thou forsaken me? Why art Thou far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring? O my God, I cry in the daytime, but thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent. But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel. Psalm 22:1-2

I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee. Ye that fear the Lord, praise Him; all ye seed of Jacob, glorify Him; and fear Him, all ye the seed of Israel. For He hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath He hid his face from him; but when he cried unto Him, He heard.

*My praise shall be of Thee in the great congregations:* I will pay my vows before them that fear Him. The meek shall eat and be satisfied; *they shall praise the Lord that seek Him:* your heart shall live forever. All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the Lord; and *all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before Thee.* For the kingdom is the Lords; and He is the governor among the nations. All they that be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: all they that go down to the dust shall bow before him: and none can keep alive his own soul. A seed shall serve him; it shall be accounted to the Lord for a generation. They shall come, and *shall declare his righteousness* unto a people that shall be born, that He hath done this. Psalm 22:22-31

I will *bless* the Lord *at all times*; his *praise* shall *continually* be in my mouth. Psalm 34:1

My soul shall make her *boast* in the Lord, the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad. Psalm 34:2

O *magnify* the Lord with me and let us *exalt* his name together. Psalm 34:3

O *clap* your hands, all ye people; *shout* unto God with the voice of triumph. Psalm 47:1

*Sing praises* to God, *sing praises: sing praises* unto our KING; *sing praises.* Psalm 47:6

Great is the Lord, and greatly to be *praised* in the city of our God, in the mountain of his holiness. Psalm 48:1

...Let the *righteous* be glad; *let them rejoice* before God: yea, let *them exceedingly rejoice.* *Sing unto God, sing praises to His name; extol Him* that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH, and *rejoice* before Him. Psalm 68:3

*Blessed be the Lord,* who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah. Psalm 68:19

The *singers went before, the players on instruments followed after; among them were the damsels playing with timbrels.* *Bless* ye God in the congregations, even the Lord, from the fountain of Israel. Psalm 68:26

*Sing* unto God, ye kingdoms of the earth; *O sing praises* unto the Lord. Selah: Psalm 68:32

*Ascribe ye strength* unto God: His *excellency* is over Israel, and His *strength* is in the clouds. O God, thou art terrible out of Thy holy places: the God of Israel is He that giveth strength and power unto his people. *Blessed be God.* Psalm 68:34-35

I will *praise the name of God with a song,* and will *magnify Him with thanksgiving.* This also shall please the Lord better than an ox or bullock that hath horns and hoofs. Psalm 69:3-31

Let the heaven and earth praise Him, the seas, and everything that moveth therein. For God will save Zion, and will build the cities of Judah: That they may dwell there, and have it in possession. The seed also of His servants shall inherit it: and they that love His name shall dwell therein. Psalm 69:34-36

So we thy people and sheep of thy pasture will give thee thanks forever: we will shew forth thy praise to all generations. Psalm 79:13

O come, let us sing to the Lord! Let us shout joyfully to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving: let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms. For the Lord is the great God, and the great King above all gods. Psalm 95:1

Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Psalm 103:1-2 (see whole chapter)

Bless the Lord. Ye His angels, that excel in strength, that do His commandments, harkening unto the voice of His word. Bless ye the Lord, all ye His hosts; ye ministers of His, that do His pleasure. Bless the Lord, all His works in all places of His dominion; bless the Lord, O my soul. Psalm 103:20-22

Bless the Lord, O my soul, O Lord my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty. Psalm 104:1 (See rest of Chapter)

I will sing unto the Lord as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. My meditation of Him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the Lord...Bless thou the Lord, O my soul. Praise ye the Lord. Psalm 104:33-35

*I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the Lord Psalm 122:1*

Sing unto the Lord a new song, and His praise from the end of th earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof. Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up their voice, the villages that Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let then shout from the top of the mountains. Let them give glory unto he Lord, and declare his praise in the islands. Isaiah 42:10-12
