Malachi 3:5-And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in his wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that aside the stranger from his right, and fear not me, saith the Lord of hosts.

Amos 8:5-Saying, when will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? And the Sabbath, that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by deceit?

Micah 6:10-Are there yet the treasures of wickedness in the house of the wicked, and the scant measure that is abominable?

Matthew 16:26-For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

James 5:4-Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which of you is kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth.

Psalm 5:9-For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; their inward part is very wickedness; their throat is an open sepulchre; they flatter with the tongue.
